# deleteSMS - Java

#### Delete a previously scheduled SMS

## **Example**

```
Hashtable<String, String> result = tmClient.deleteSMS("1234");
System.out.println("Message with ID " + result.get("scheduled_id") + " was " + result.get("status"));
```

### Arguments:

#### String scheduled\_id:

#### Returns:

A Hashtable with 2 keys: 'scheduled\_id', 'status' e.g. result.get("source\_credits\_after")

# The account number of the account to transfer the credits to (available in the web-based UI)

Hashtable key	Value
scheduled_id	String: The unique ID of the scheduled message.
status	The status of the message, i.e., DELETED.

# Specific error codes:

Code	Meaning
35	The provided Resource ID is not valid or is malformed.
36	This can have multiple meanings: either  1) the scheduled message id doesn't exist or belongs to other account than the one using the REST API; or  2) the scheduled message has already been sent and, as so, can't be deleted.
